



SAFETY ALERT: March 16, 2020

This safety alert is to inform the Carnegie Mellon community about an off-campus burglary and attempted robbery.

A CMU student reported to CMU Police and Pittsburgh Police that she was alone in her apartment at 5:30 this morning when a suspect entered her apartment through an unlocked living room window. The apartment is in The Amberson Apartments at 4 Bayard Rd. The suspect confronted the victim and demanded money. The victim was able to flee the apartment and leave the building. She was unharmed. The suspect fled the area on foot.

Pittsburgh Police are investigating.
