



Scenario 2010 - 2050




World GDP (constant USD), Source: Global Europe 2050

Around 50% of the world population live in cities


- → expected to rise to 60% by 2030




The 'Smart Cities and Communities' European Innovation Partnership

- Success means: attracting <u>finance</u>




