NOTE: You should NOT pursue any engagement with individuals or entities based in these countries/regions without first consulting with the Export Compliance Group (ECG) with as much advance notice as possible.

NOTE: You should engage the Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP), the Office of the Vice Provost for Education (OVPE) and/or University Advancement (UA) representatives as early as possible when considering a research, education or philanthropic engagement with an entity or individual based in a country of concern that will require a contract of any kind.
