

2026-2027 Verification of Identity (Video Call)

This form is to verify the identity of a student to complete V4/V5 federal verification for federal aid eligibility. Per [Electronic Announcement 25-16](#), if a student is unable to appear in person, a student's identity can be verified via a video call between a designated Carnegie Mellon staff member and the student. The student must have their video enabled and show a valid, unexpired government-issued photo ID during the call. A designated Carnegie Mellon staff member will use the video call to verify the student's identity and ID with a screenshot. Acceptable forms of ID include, but are not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or U.S. passport.
