Hours of Operation & General Information

Curfew Policy

Day Guest Policy

Any guests that will be entering the residential facility must be listed on the Emergency Contact form submitted through the enrollment portal. Guests will be required to sign in and out of the building and wear a wristband distributed daily at the entrance to the buildings. We will not permit any overnight guests in the residence halls. All guests must vacate the residence hall before building curfew (11:00 PM on Friday and Saturday)
