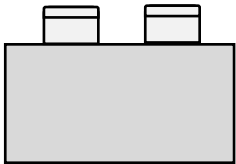


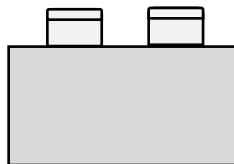
STUDENT GOVERNANCE

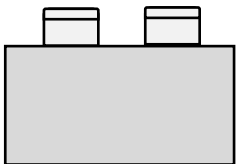

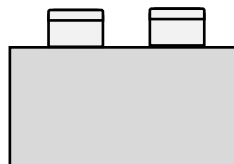
