Attached, please find the information on twenty-three chapters that comprised the fraternity and sorority community at Carnegie Mellon University for Spring 2013. As we work to raise awareness of the fraternity and sorority contributions to the Carnegie Mellon community, the information reported here will be shared with university administrators, faculty and staff, the fraternities and sororities, chapter advisors and presidents, and the national offices.

This report highlights the achievements of last semester. In Spring 2013, the fraternities and sororities contributed a total of 9,872.5 hours of community service and raised \$40,984.50 in donations for local and national charities. Of the chapters who reported their involvement about 75% of members were involved in other campus organizations at Carnegie Mellon with about 50% of these students serving in leadership positions.

Academically, ten of the fraternities and sororities earned average QPAs at or at or above the university undergraduate average of 3.24 this Spring.

Fraternity and Sorority Life Report, Spring 2013

Membership

- 23 fraternities and sororities were active at Carnegie Mellon: 6 Panhellenic sororities; 11 Interfraternity Council fraternities; 3 Asian-Interest groups (1 fraternity and 2 sororities); and 3 National Pan-Hellenic Council, Inc. (NPHC) chapters were active for Spring 2013.
- Of Carnegie Mellon's 5,557 undergraduate students, 1,197 are members of fraternities or sororities making up 22% of the student population. 597 women are affiliated with a sorority, reflecting 25% of the female undergraduate population. 600 men are affiliated with a fraternity, reflecting 19% of the male undergraduate population.
- The average size of a Panhellenic (PHC) sorority is 88 women. The average size of an Interfraternity Council (IFC) fraternity is 50 men. The average size of a multi-cultural (MGC) fraternity and sorority is 20 people.
- A total of 131 new members joined the fraternity and sorority community this semester: 41 women joined PHC sororities; 77 men joined IFC fraternities; and 13 men and women joined the NPHC and Asian-Interest organizations.

Scholarship/Leadership

- This Spring, 10 chapters had QPAs at or above the all-university average (3.24): Alpha Chi Omega; Delta Gamma; Delta Delta Delta; Kappa Alpha Theta; Kappa Kappa Gamma; Alpha Epsilon Pi; Delta Tau Delta; Phi Delta Theta; Sigma Phi Epsilon; Kappa Phi Lambda.
- 6 sororities had QPAs above the all-women's average of 3.25: Alpha Chi Omega; Delta Gamma; Delta Delta Delta; Kappa Alpha Theta; Kappa Kappa Gamma; Kappa Phi Lambda. 4 fraternities had QPAs above the all-men's average of 3.22: Alpha Epsilon Pi; Delta Tau Delta; Phi Delta Theta; Sigma Phi Epsilon. The all IFC QPA average was 3.19. The all PHC QPA average was 3.28. The all NPHC QPA average was 3.14. The all Asian-Interest QPA average was 3.11.
- 150 members of the Greek community received a 4.0 for the Spring 2013 semester.
- Order of Omega, an honorary society with a commitment to scholarship and leadership for Greek men and women, inducted 5 new members this Spring.
- Rho Lambda, an honorary society for Panhellenic women exhibiting leadership in their community, inducted 9 new members.

Community Service and Philanthropy

- The Greek community contributed 9,872.5 hours of community service this semester for programs such as St. Jude's, Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh, Service for Sight, and Court Appointed Special Advocates.
- Three (3) chapters demonstrated superior commitment to community service: Kappa Sigma contributed a total of 2,927 hours; Kappa Alpha Theta contributed a total of 1,382 hours; and Kappa Kappa Gamma contributed 1,406.3 hours of community service.
- During the Spring semester, chapters raised a total of \$40,984.50 for local, national and international charities.
- The largest monetary donation during the Spring semester was from Sigma Chi through their philanthropy event Derby Days, raising \$10,054.04 for the Children's Miracle Network and the Huntsman Cancer Institute.
- The annual Spring Greek community philanthropy event Greek Sing raised a record breaking amount, \$74,203.31 for the Children's Institute of Pittsburgh.

Campus Involvement

- 74.8% of active Greek members reported involvement in other campus organizations of which, 49.5% served in leadership roles.
- 13 of the chapters opted into Standard of Excellence for the Spring 2013. These chapters have committed to the overall enhancement of their members, their chapter, and the community. Standards of Excellence chapters are committed to promoting the academic mission of the University, developing leadership and character in members, providing service to the community, and fostering life-long friendships between members.
