Startup Funding

Prizes, PRIs, Philanthropy

The 2% Barrier

- 2023 lowest venture funding since 2018
- 38% decline YOY
- Seed funding in Q4 2023 ~\$7B, ~4,500 deals
- Female founders receive only 2% of VC funding
 - Black and Latino women founders .1%
 - Women start ¹/₃ of all businesses
- Black founders less than 2%
- Impact companies less than 2%

Alternative Routes for Seed

- A great opportunity for minority-founded and impact startups
- ROI + SROI (Social Return on Investment)
- Impact Reporting and Investment Standards (IRIS) Global Impact Investment Network (GIIN)

- Philanthropy Program-Related Investments (PRIs)
- Prizes
- Fellowships
- Impact Investing
 - Social Impact Funds and Patient Capital
 - Social Impact Bonds
 - Quasi-Equity Revenue Sharing Agreements
- Funding organizations often provide more than one of the above

Philanthropy

- Not just for nonprofits anymore
- Grants
 - Examples: Roddenberry Catalyst,
- Program-Related Investments (and Mission-Related Investments)
 - PRIs are a tax designation 1969 Tax Act
 - 130,000 foundations in the United States
 - \$1.1T in endowments
- Best resource: Foundation Directory
- Some examples:
 - Richard King Mellon Foundation
 - <u>McConnell Foundation</u> (Canada) Target to 100% impact investing by 2028

Prizes | Competitions

Often includes Accelerators and other strategic programming

- <u>Hult Prize</u> \$1M impact companies founded by students
- Earthshot Prize GBP1M focused on climate
- MASSChallenge
- Norrsken Accelerator \$125,000 + 8 week program in Stockholm
- Buckminster Fuller Design Challenge \$100,000
- <u>CISCO Innovation Challenge</u> \$1M in prizes

Fellowships

Typically grants + ongoing network creation and support for founders

Impact Investing - Patient Capital and Social Impact Funds

"Impact investment as those made to generate positive, measurable social and environmental impact alongside a financial return."

\$502 billion, managed by over 1,340 organizations. Projected to be \$1T by 2025

The market has grown by 10 times since 2009 when funds under impact investment were \$50 billion.

Patient Capital - Acumen defines patient capital as debt or equity investment capital with a long-term investment horizon of seven to 12 years, a high tolerance for risk, and a goal of maximizing both social and financial returns.
